# Do you have fears for your safety when attending court?

You have a right to feel safe at court. The Courts place a priority on safety and can assist with the safety of you and your family when attending court.

If you have any concerns for your safety it is important you let the Courts know prior to attending a court event, including conferences or hearings.

### You can inform the Courts by calling 1300 352 000

You can discuss your concerns with a Client Service Officer if you already have the contact number of the Officer dealing with your case. The Officer will ask you a few questions and decide what arrangements are needed to enable you to participate in court events safely.

- You should call at least two days before your court event so arrangements can be made for your safety.
- If there is an existing family violence order, you must tell the Courts before your first court event.

- The police
- Your lawyer
- One of the agencies listed on the back of this flyer.

The Courts encourage you to also contact the services listed for further information and advice, including options for remaining safe outside the Courts.

Some aspects of family violence may be a criminal offence and you may need to report these to police or child protection authorities.
